



Help and Information about our Web Site

Learning to find your way around our web site will help you to keep up to date with what is happening in The Quilters' Guild. You will find information about your local activities in your regional section and other events, both in the UK and abroad should be publicised in the What's On? Section.

We know that many people are very familiar with finding their way around the web but if you need a little help here is an explanation of how our own web site works.

Our Home page is displayed as soon as you enter our web site and shows pictures which represent the various sections of our site.

We also have a main menu which is always shown in the left hand margin on your screen.

You can place your mouse pointer over the picture on the Home page or over the left hand menu item which interests you and click your left mouse button. To move to a different page at any time you can use the left hand menu again or return to the Home page and start again from there.

The information shown in the middle of your screen will change to show you about the item you have selected, for example, "About Us" will introduce The Quilters' Guild.

At the same time the menu in the left hand margin will now show more items connected to your first choice. If you choose "About Us" then there will now be an extra menu in paler type below "About Us". It will look like this –

If you want to check our contact information, move your mouse pointer over "Contact The Guild", click the left button again and you will reach the page which shows all our current contact information.

To move on to something else at any time you can point and click at any item in the menu on the left side of your screen.
