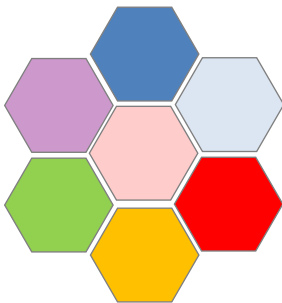




Hexi Flower pincushion

You will need .. Needle & thread, pins, scissors, Scraps,
2x buttons and stuffing.

1. Prepare 14 hexagons following the English Paper Piecing Guide on enclosed sheet.
2. Sew hexagons together using a small whip stitch ~ see EPP Guide sheet



Make a flower shape by sewing six hexagons
around a central hexagon then repeat for
second flower.

3. Once you have two completed flowers place them right sides together and whip stitch around the entire flower .. Leaving two edges open for turning right sides out.
4. Press your completed EPP block and remove paper pieces and tacking thread
5. Turn right sides out, carefully poking out the corners and stuff firmly.
6. Slipstitch the opening closed.
7. Thread the button through the centre using doubled thread, pulling tightly.

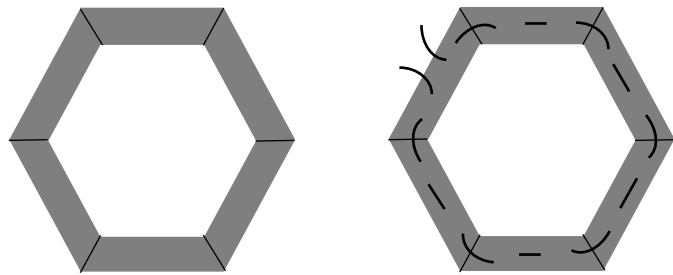


English Paper Piecing (EPP) Instructions

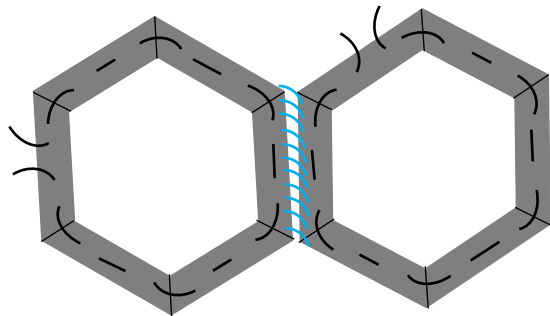
1. Pin your paper template onto your fabric and then cut your fabric at least 1/4" larger than the paper template



2. Fold the fabric over the sides of the paper template and tack to keep in place, remove pin



3. Place fabric shapes right side together and whipstitch along the edge, avoiding catching the paper with your stitches. Aim for roughly 14-16 stitches per inch.



TIP .. For pointed shapes such as diamonds keep your tails facing the same direction so they create a fanning effect when joining them together.
